Your appointment will take approximately 1-2 hours, depending on what you are being seen for. To enable our doctor to examine the back of your eye, it will probably be necessary to put drops in your eyes that will dilate your pupils and may make you sensitive to light, interfere with your ability to read or make your distance vision blurry, for a short period of time.

It will speed up your registration process as a new patient if you do the following before you arrive:

- Fill out the enclosed forms and bring them with you.
- Include the correct name and dosage of your medications.
- Bring any and all insurance cares that apply, along with your driver's license or state identification card.
- Also, if your insurance requires a referral from a primary care provider, please have it sent prior to your appointment with us.
- All insurance co-pays and deductibles are payable at the time services are rendered, so please be prepared to pay those charges at the conclusion of your visit.

We are located on Greater Mack Avenue at Shady Lane, about a quarter mile north of Eight Mile Road. (St. Joan of Arc Church is across the street from us!). We are east of I-94 and either the Vernier Exit, or the Nine Mile Road Exit will bring you here quickly.
